<b>Symptoms</b>	Painful, open sores that appear inside lips & cheeks, at base of gums, or under tongue	Appear around the lips or at the corners of the mouth
<b>Medical Name</b>	Aphthous ulcers	Herpetic lesions
<b>Cause</b>	Stress, poor nutrition, food allergies, illness, hormonal changes, trauma	Outbreak of herpes simplex virus (HSV-1)
